

CLEP (College Level Examination Program)--CLEP is a national testing program that awards college credit for some introductory courses. The exams cost \$75 each (costs subject to change) and are administered daily. To register for a CLEP exam or for more information, contact UAF testing services at (907) 474-5277.

The following criteria apply to CLEP exams:

1. If you've earned as many as six semester credits in the area of humanities, social sciences/history, natural sciences or college mathematics, no credit will be awarded for successfully completing the general exam in those subject areas, which are highlighted in the [CLEP exam list](#).
2. You may not duplicate a course for which you've already been given credit or in which you're currently enrolled.
3. If you've audited a course, you must wait at least one year after the end of that course before taking the CLEP exam for that course .
4. The minimum passing scores for approved CLEP exams is 50 with the exception of the following Level II (2nd year) listed foreign languages scores: French Level II minimum 52, German Level II minimum 63, and Spanish Level II minimum 66.
