

Conditional and Clear Admission

Once the Office of Admissions receives and evaluates application materials, UAF will mail a letter of acceptance to qualified applicants. This letter will list any conditions under which the student is being admitted. Qualified applicants who are in their last year of high school or who are attending another college will receive *conditional* acceptance. Students may also be admitted conditionally pending receipt of ACT or SAT scores. Admission becomes “clear” only when the Office of Admissions receives all required documents, including final official transcripts certifying graduation, and test scores.

Financial aid cannot be disbursed for a student until all required admission documents have been received.
