

## UNDERGRADUATE TEST SCORE POLICY

**Bachelor's Degree Applicants:** Freshmen and transfer applicants with fewer than 30 semester credit hours must submit the results of either the ACT or SAT examinations (ACT preferred). The test scores must be no more than two years old. This requirement will be waived if you have successfully completed with a grade of "C" or better within the last two years the equivalent of three credits each of 100-level Math and English composition from a regionally-accredited institution.

Certificate and Associate Degree Applicants: Applicants with fewer than 30 semester credit hours who apply to a certificate or associate degree program requiring English or mathematics coursework must submit the results of the ACT, SAT, ASSET or COMPASS tests. The test scores must be no more than two years old.

The Office of Admissions will accept test scores sent directly from the test administration service, or scores posted to a high school transcript.
