

UAF Visual Art Academy Rules and Expectations

The following guidelines for respectful behavior have been developed to provide an atmosphere of safety and creative learning. Parents, please go over these guidelines and rules with your child before signing.

The UAF Visual Art Academy promotes and supports the following positive behaviors:

Trustworthiness, truthfulness, active listening, respect, participation, and all efforts toward students expressing their personal best.

The UAF Visual Art Academy does not tolerate the following unacceptable behaviors:

Put downs, threats, bullying, hate language, including labeling and name-calling, swearing, or destruction of property, both personal and public.

RULES

- 1.) Use or possession of alcohol or non-medically prescribed drugs is not allowed. Violation of this rule will result in expulsion from Academy.
- 2.) **NO WEAPONS of any sort are allowed on the UAF campus and the Visual Art Academy.** This list includes, but is not limited to, knives, guns, pepper spray, and toy guns. **Students bringing weapons to campus may expect to be immediately expelled and sent home.**
- 3.) Students must attend and fully participate in all classes for which they are enrolled. They are expected to cooperate fully and respectfully with their instructors.
- 4.) Students will behave respectfully toward university employees and facilities, particularly with regard to individuals and equipment at the Wood Center Dining and recreation areas and the Lola Tilly Commons.
- 5.) The use of skateboards is not allowed on campus. This is University policy; please respect it. If a student chooses to bring a skateboard to camp and use it, the University Police or the Academy staff may confiscate it and issue a “trespass” notice. Please help us by observing this rule.
- 6.) If you break these rules: first, there will be a warning; after the second violation you will see the director and the student will then call their parents.
