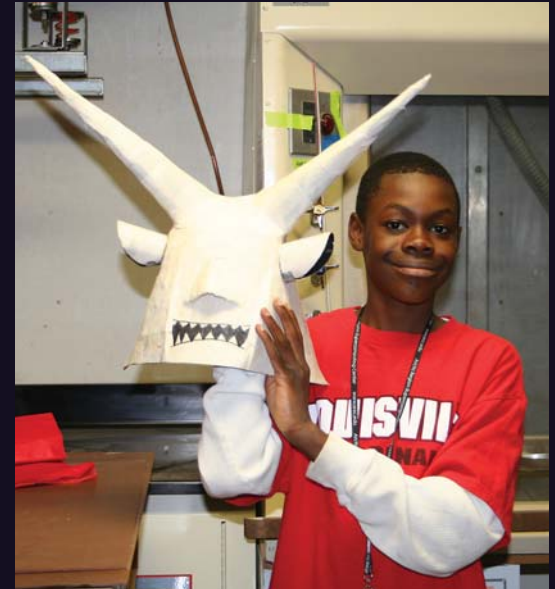

Digital Photography

Learn technical and esthetic aspects in the creation of artwork in the digital world of photography.

Computer Art or Animation

Digital pixel painting & design processes to create images using Photoshop in a university computer lab or experimental animation including stopmotion and 2D animation.

Painting

Color and design using acrylic paints; new methods, compositional studies, painting from life and mixed-media projects.

Printmaking

Relief and collagraph printmaking techniques using manual and printing press methods.

Sculpture and 3-D Design

Sculptural projects using a wide variety of techniques and materials including found objects, clay, plaster, metal, wire and wood.

Ceramics

Hand-thrown and hand-built clay pottery using a variety of glazing and firing techniques.

Metalsmithing

Jewelry and metalsmithing projects in copper and brass with the opportunity to work in silver.

Drawing and Design

Fundamentals in drawing & design with new & traditional materials and exciting contemporary methods.
