


Coordinated Review


- Office of Project Management and Permitting
 - Unique to the State of Alaska
- Coordinated projects include:
 - Oil and Gas
 - Mining
 - Renewable energy
 - Federal planning
 - Transportation
- Assures that agency speak to each other and consider each agencies perspective when making decisions
- Gives the State one voice

Coordination Goals

- Establish communication protocols between State agencies, the public, applicant, feds, and other stakeholders
- Eliminate shot gun approach
- Make sure that each agency is making decisions using the same and most current information
- Make sure each agency is aware of project activities and review processes
- Reduce impacts by identifying and understanding agency needs & requirements early on in the process allowing applicants to propose a project that considers those needs in the early stages of design
- Projects, if constructed, are better designed to consider all agency needs early on in the process
