

CALL FOR PROPOSALS



JAMES R. CROOK MEMORIAL FUND

Purpose

To assist undergraduate and graduate students conducting research in the area of Environmental Health Sciences, in its broadest perspective, at UAF who may have either no current funding or only limited funding. All research methodologies are eligible for consideration, including those in the social & behavioral sciences.

Qualifications Pertaining to Recipients

Recipient must be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate or graduate student at UAF in a program leading to a bachelor's, master's, or doctoral degree. Recipients must maintain an academic standing sufficient to meet the requirements of the appropriate degree program and have achieved a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 at the time of the application.

Contents of Proposals

Research proposals shall be for an undergraduate or graduate fellowship in the area of Environmental Health Sciences in its broadest perspective. Such proposals must include:

- A description of the proposed undergraduate or graduate research in Environmental Health Sciences.
- A description of how the research is related to the advancement of knowledge in the area of Environmental Health Sciences.
- An explanation of the proposed budget.
- Unofficial transcripts of any undergraduate or graduate coursework completed at any institution (including UAF).
- A current résumé or curriculum vitae.
- A letter from a qualified appropriate research supervisor or academic advisor acknowledging responsibility for supervision of the research.
- Two letters of reference describing the qualifications and character of the applicant.

Successful recipients will agree to submit a copy of a final report, preferably in publishable form, to the Development Office for submission to the donor. The final report is due within three months after the semester(s) this award is in effect.

Should a thesis, dissertation, or published manuscript be written after the due date of the final report which includes results obtained from this fellowship, a copy of the thesis, dissertation, or published manuscript will also be submitted to the Development Office. In such cases, an appropriate acknowledgement of the receipt of funding from the donor through this fellowship will be included in the manuscript.
