Responsible Conduct of Research

If you didn't get a chance to sign up for the 2-credit professional course LAS:693 Responsible conduct of research, you can still complete the UAF web-based training program in the Responsible Conduct of Research http://www.uaf.edu/ori/RCR_Course/about.html Either course fulfills National Science Foundation and National Institutes of Health requirements that funded trainees (e.g, graduate students & undergraduate students) receive formal instruction in the Responsible Conduct of Research. It is particularly beneficial for new investigators, and in the past, the VCR has required course completion as a condition of exemptions from UAF's PI eligibility policy.

CLA Undergraduate Research Opportunities Program

RFPs have been distributed to all CLA units and department chairs. We hope to have strong show of interest and good pool of proposals for this one-time money. ALL liberal arts disciplines are eligible. Applications are due mid-November so that decisions can be made early enough for students may make use of the funds over the semester break period if their project warrants it. 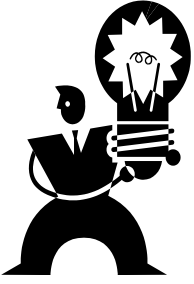
