



Transfer Scholarship Application

2011-2012



The UAF College of Liberal Arts will award up to four \$5,000 transfer scholarships for the 2011-2012 academic year. Preference will be given to members of Phi Theta Kappa. Eligible students must be accepted into a College of Liberal Arts degree program prior to the start of the fall 2011 semester and be enrolled full-time (12 credits/semester minimum). The scholarship is open only to students in undergraduate degree programs. For the purpose of this scholarship, "transfer student" is defined as a student transferring at least 30 semester credits from another institution. Preference will be given to students having completed an associate degree from a regionally accredited institution prior to the start of the fall 2011 semester.

Applicants must submit this completed application form, an essay detailing why they want to study in Alaska (1000 word maximum), a summary of academic, educational and or artistic achievements, honors, activities and accomplishments (300 word maximum) and a college transcript (unofficial copies are acceptable).

To apply, submit this application along with the required attachments by May 31, 2011 to UAF College of Liberal Arts Dean's Office, Transfer Scholarship Review, P.O.
