Healthcare Reimbursement; medical billing and coders are a necessary part of all medical offices, clinics, hospitals and long term care facilities.

Certified Nurse Aides work with nurses, physician's assistants and physicians to provide the highest quality medical care possible for patients in offices, clinics, hospitals and long term care facilities.

Certified Medical Assistants will find career opportunities in office reception, reimbursement, and office management or working with physicians and other health care providers assisting with medical examinations or providing educational information to patients.

Dental Assistants work with dentist and other professionals in dental offices and clinics assisting with dental procedures.

Emergency Medical Services students are provided with the knowledge and experiences necessary for entry level EMT positions as well as preparation for a career as paramedics.

Medical and Dental Receptionist are able to work in medical and dental offices as well as clinics, hospitals and long term care facilities.

Phlebotomists are trained to safely draw blood samples and can find career opportunities in doctors' offices, clinics, hospitals, and laboratories
