If accepted into the Alaska Native Teacher Preparation Project:

- **I can reasonably anticipate completing all coursework for my degree and teaching certificate by May 2011.**
- **I will complete a minimum of 12 credits toward my degree each semester and maintain good standing per program criteria.**
- **I agree to participate in program cohort activities including travel to 2 workshops per year.**
- **I will contact the ANTPP Program each semester to keep them informed about my progress and my current contact information.**
- **I understand that I may not be employed more than 20 hours per week if I am accepted as a project participant (not applicable during induction year).**
- **I agree to furnish a copy of proof of tribal affiliation to ANTPP.**
- **I agree to the terms of the Participant Payback Agreement.**
- **INTERNSHIP STUDENTS: I give permission for the ANTPP Admissions Committee to view my autobiographical sketch and letters of recommendation in my School of Education file.**

PAYBACK AGREEMENT

Participants receiving training under this program are required to pay back, either through service or cash, an equivalent amount of time or cost of the training received. *Payback is to begin within six months from the Participant's completion of a degree or withdrawal from the program, whichever occurs first.*

Participants must agree that information on the participant, and his or her training program, may be provided to the U.S. Department of Education-Office of Indian Education, the cognizant agency responsible for ensuring completion of the payback requirements.

The participants must obtain approval from the Office of Indian Education of the type of service to be performed when a service payback is performed. Upon approval of a service payback, the Participant is required to provide a semi-annual certification, from his or her supervisor, of continuous employment. Failure to comply with the payback requirements may jeopardize the Participant's ability to obtain future federal student aid.

Service (Work-Related) Payback:

- Participants are required to perform a work-related service, in the same area as training received that benefits Alaska Native/American Indian students (i.e., elementary teacher training requires an elementary position for payback).
- The payback will be continuous service equal to the total amount of time for which training is received.

Cash Payback:

A cash payback is required when the participant:

- Withdraws or is terminated as a Participant from the program;
- Chooses not to complete a service payback upon program completion; or
- Is unable to complete the service payback started; in this case, a pro-rated cash payback will be based on the period of service payback completed.

Participants are responsible for a cash payback (when no service payback has been performed) of the total cost of the training received during the time of this agreement.

Cash paybacks will be based on a payment schedule approved by the Office of Indian Education.
