

TIMELINE AND SCHEDULE OF CLASSES OF SECONDARY POST-BACCALAUREATE LICENSURE PROGRAM FAST TRACK OPTION

PHASE 1: SUMMER SEMESTER - 9 CREDITS TOTAL – Courses offered on the UAF campus
Interns spend six weeks on the Fairbanks campus.

EDSC 407	Developing Literacy in the Content Areas (3 credits): 12-week course
EDSC 415	Foundations of Modern Educational Practice (3 credits): three-week course
EDSC 414/614	Learning, Development, and Special Needs Instruction (3 credits): three-week course
ED 237 A,B,C,D	Interns who have not completed these four half-credit courses by passing the classes, by passing the technology challenge, or a combination of the first two options, will be required to enroll in four half-credit web-based classes.

PHASE 2: FALL SEMESTER- 12 CREDITS TOTAL – Courses offered on the UAF campus or by Audio conference for those candidates residing outside the Fairbanks Area.
Interns will spend a minimum of half-days with their mentors at their school site, five days a week.

EDSC 402	Methods of Teaching in Secondary School (3 credits) Fairbanks interns: This class begins in late-August and is a daytime class. Off campus interns: Audio conference evening course.
EDSC 458/658	Classroom Organization & Management (3 credits). Fairbanks interns: This class begins in mid-October. Off campus interns: Audio conference evening course.
EDSC 431/631-436/636	Secondary Instruction and Assessment in the Content Area (3 credits) Class meets weekly as a Fairbanks and audio conference course – evening course
EDSC 471	Secondary Teaching: School Internship I and Seminar (3 credits). Usually begins mid-August <i>In addition to school site requirement:</i> Fairbanks interns: Evening course - Meets every other week – dates TBA Off campus interns: Audio conference evening course – dates TBA

PHASE 3: SPRING SEMESTER- 12 CREDITS TOTAL – Courses offered on the UAF Campus or by audio conference for those candidates residing outside the Fairbanks area.
Interns will spend full-days with their mentor at their school site five days a week.

EDSC 442/642	Portfolio Preparation: Integrating Theory and Practice (2 credits) – evening course
EDSC 457/657	Multicultural Education and School-Community Relations (4 credits) – evening course
EDSC 472	Secondary Teaching: School Internship II and Seminar (3 credits). This class usually begins in January. <i>In addition to school site requirement:</i> Fairbanks interns: Evening course – meets every other week – dates TBA Off campus interns: Audio conference evening course – dates TBA

Spring semester may include a rural practicum.

PHASE 4 (OPTIONAL):

Course work approved by intern's committee toward M.Ed. Secondary Education
