

**TIMELINE AND SCHEDULE OF CLASSES**  
**UAF SECONDARY POST-BACCALAUREATE LICENSURE PROGRAM**  
**FAST TRACK SCHEDULE**

**SUMMER SEMESTER - 9 CREDITS TOTAL** – Courses offered *only* on the UAF campus  
*Interns will spend approximately six weeks on the Fairbanks campus.*

- EDSC 407      Developing Literacy in the Content Areas (3 credits)
- EDSC 415      Foundations of Modern Educational Practice (3 credits)  
 OR EDSC 205, Introduction to Secondary Education, offered spring semesters on the Fairbanks campus,  
 may be used to meet this course requirement.
- EDSC 414/614    Learning, Development, and Special Needs Instruction (3 credits)
- ED 237 A,B,C,D    Interns who have not completed these four half-credit courses by passing the classes, by passing the  
 technology challenge, or a combination of these options, will be required to enroll in four half-  
 credit web-based classes during the summer semester.

**FALL SEMESTER- 12 CREDITS TOTAL** – Courses offered on the UAF campus or by Audio conference for those candidates residing  
 outside the Fairbanks Area. *Interns will spend a minimum of half-days with their mentors at their school site, five days a week.*

- EDSC 402                      Methods of Teaching in Secondary School (3 credits)  
 Fairbanks interns: Class begins late-August and ends mid- October -- daytime class.  
 Off campus interns: Audio conference evening course.
- EDSC 458/658                Classroom Organization & Management (3 credits).  
 Fairbanks interns: Class begins mid-October and ends mid December – daytime class  
 Off campus interns: Audio conference evening course.
- EDSC 431/631-436/636    Secondary Instruction and Assessment in the Content Area (3 credits)  
 Interns complete a content specific method's course that matches their undergraduate degree.  
 Each content specific method's class meets once a week as a combined Fairbanks  
 and audio conference course – evening course
- EDSC 471                      Secondary Teaching: School Internship I and Seminar (3 credits). Usually begins mid-August  
*In addition to half-day minimum school site requirement:*  
 Fairbanks interns: Seminar - Evening course - Meets every other week  
 Off campus interns: Audio conference evening course – dates and times TBA

**SPRING SEMESTER- 9 CREDITS TOTAL** – Courses offered on the UAF Campus or by audio conference for those candidates  
 residing outside the Fairbanks area. *Interns will spend full-days with their mentor at their school site five days a week.*

- EDSC 442/642    Teaching with Technology (3 credits) – evening course  
 Some of this course work will be delivered during fall semester.  
 Fairbanks interns: evening class  
 Off campus interns: Audio conference evening course during both fall and spring -TBA
- EDSC 457/657    Multicultural Education and School-Community Relations (4 credits) – evening course  
 Fairbanks Interns: Once a week evening course  
 Off-campus intern – Weekly audio conference evening course
- EDSC 472                      Secondary Teaching: School Internship II and Seminar (3 credits). This class begins in January.  
*In addition to school site requirement: - full time at your school site*  
 Fairbanks interns: Seminar - Evening course – meets every other week – dates TBA  
 Off campus interns: Seminar - Audio conference evening course – dates TBA

Course work approved by intern's committee toward M.Ed. Secondary Education
