Fall and spring classes are offered by audio conference and can be completed from your teaching site.

Applicants are encouraged to apply early in order to be eligible for an initial Alaska teaching license prior to beginning their job search in the spring.

1st Fall Semester

EDSC 458/658 -- Classroom Organization & Management (3) – audio conference night course

1st Spring Semester

EDSC 457/657 -- Multicultural Education Seminar (4) – audio conference night course

1st Summer Semester – *If hired and admitted prior to June – candidates are encouraged to complete these courses prior to the 1st fall semester – Courses are offered on the University of Alaska Fairbanks campus. Candidates who choose to wait, must complete them during the summer semester following their first year of teaching. Candidates that have not met the computer competency requirement must complete ED 237 Technology Tools, 2 credits, during the summer semester.*

2nd Fall Semester

EDSC 471 -- Secondary Teaching: School Internship I and Seminar (3) – Course includes audio conference seminars - night course

2nd Spring Semester

EDSC 442/642 – Teaching with Technology (3) – audio conference night course – some instruction delivered during fall semester.
