There is NO spam or advertising. Nixle is available at no cost (standard text message rates apply for cell phone subscribers who do not have text plans with their cell phone providers). The service is simple to use, reliable and trusted. You decide what information you want and whether you want it sent to your cell phone, email, or just simply over the web.
