2. Volunteer to help usher for a performance (*get to see the shows for free*) or work on the running crew.

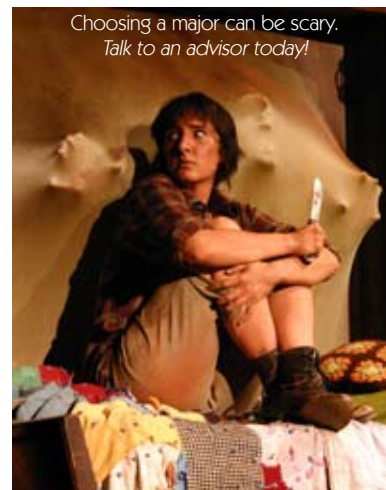
