The Bethel 4-H Youth Center (B4-HY Center) is a City of Bethel/Cooperative Extension Service 4-H Program collaboration coordinated by the Parks & Recreation Department staff. The B4-HY Center is a safe haven for your child/children.

The B4-HY Center has a Teen and Young Adult In-School Program (18 to 21 years old, with verification) available every night from 6:00 PM to 9:30 PM Monday through Friday.

The B4-HY Center staff is committed to the best possible care for your child/children. There are a variety of regularly scheduled activities available to participate in during the school year-4-H Teen Council, cooking, arts & crafts, video and board games, a 3 station computer lab, Wii Games, air hockey, ping pong and foosball. We also have a big screen TV.

The Weight Room is available at no cost for teens 14 to 18 with parental permission. The information and form is included on a separate info sheet at this website.

During the school year a free Teen snack is provided from 7:30 to 8PM. We also have a free Summer Food Service Program, provided by USDA, for all youth that is described on a separate info sheet at this website.

We do sign youth in every night so we know who is in the facility at all times.

The annual Teen fee is \$20
