Changes in Red

**Clothing for ALL Contests:**

Standard English or Western Attire must be worn during the contest and at the awards presentation. No open toed shoes or sandals, crop-top shirts or shorts will be allowed. Shirts must be tucked in.

**Horse Judging:**

**Clothing for FFA during Horse Judging:**

FFA will be joining the horse judging portion of our contest this year. They will need to be in official FFA attire in order to participate.

**Horse Judging Hat/Helmet Rule:**

Hats are prohibited in the judging area. A hat or helmet is optional when giving reasons.
