Shishmaref, Alaska, is located on Sarichef Island in the Chukchi Sea and is highly vulnerable to coastal erosion, thawing permafrost and flooding. Relocation efforts began in 2001, but people and property are still at risk. Scholarships have contributed to Ralph's academic success and he will be able to apply what he has learned at UAF to help Shishmaref — to save his home.

Ralph is graduating this semester with a bachelor of science degree in civil engineering. He explains his goals after graduation by saying, “I plan to help Alaska's economy through my work while I gain valuable engineering experience to prepare for helping Shishmaref.”

Ralph's whole university experience has been funded by scholarships; he will be graduating debt-free. “Every scholarship I am awarded is an inspiration which fuels me every semester to be the best student I can be.” Ralph would like scholarship donors to know, “You are just one person and can only pursue your own dream. When you inspire others, you are enabling the pursuit of many dreams.”

But before she goes, Hannah wants to say thank you to UAF donors. “You are doing an awesome thing,” she says, “providing opportunity, peace of mind and academic encouragement to students wanting to strive and pursue their dreams.”

Nina Tartakoff on the legacy of her cousin, Nathan Gerson

In many ways Nathan Gerson lived the life of a true Alaskan. He served in the Merchant Marine, worked in the goldfields, built a number of cabins, flew a plane and spent much of his life outdoors. He was an avid bottle and stove door collector, making trips to the old mining camps near Dawson City and throughout Alaska to look for the best specimens. There is a photo of him holding a stove door from the Chilkoot trail which looked exactly like a stove door he had hanging on the wall in his kitchen. As a pilot and outdoorsman he knew the value of a lightweight saw which he could easily carry on his travels. He designed a popular folding saw best known in Fairbanks as Nat's Pak Saw and could be seen selling them in the Wood Center at the University Women's Association Christmas bazaar.

Nathan's purpose in providing the Gerson Family Memorial Scholarship is to give students who would not be able to afford it otherwise and who overcame some challenge or obstacle in their lives an opportunity to go to college. I believe his intent with this stipulation was he wanted people granted

this scholarship to appreciate the opportunity to gain an education and work hard toward their goals. Nathan was so unselfish to stash all his spare money in order to help provide an education to students in need or who face adversity or barriers.

UAF has had a huge impact on my life. I received my master's degree in education in counseling at UAF in 1986 and am now a retired high school counselor. I was fortunate to be hired as a UAF staff member for the Fast Track Program and Tech Prep Program at the UAF Community and Technical College.

Having been a high school counselor and seeing the struggles of students trying to juggle money for further education, **it makes me very proud and honored to have the opportunity to meet the students chosen to receive the Gerson Family Scholarship.**

Nathan would be very proud of the opportunities he has provided. I believe he would have wanted his legacy of giving to continue for many years to come, which is why his entire estate was given for UAF scholarships. **Thank you for carrying on Nathan's dream by excelling at yours.**

Trevor Adams, viola

Trevor Adams is from North Pole. He began playing violin in the fourth grade, but switched to viola in high school. Trevor is now a junior at UAF and thinks he would like to go on to earn a doctoral degree in composition or performance. "Scholarship support has allowed me to spend more time on music and not on how I will pay for school," Trevor says. He participates in university ensembles and recently joined a Fairbanks community band. "These music activities give me additional opportunities to practice improvisation and improve my ear training." At a minimum, Trevor would like to compose music and play in a symphony orchestra. He plans to give back to the music community by becoming a college professor and educating future musicians.

Franz Felkl, violin

Franz Felkl grew up in Juneau, Alaska. He feels very fortunate to have found his calling in life at such an early age, and wants to play and teach music for the rest of his life. At age 12 Franz played his first solo performance with the Juneau Symphony, and later that year he joined the symphony as a first violinist. He has been very active in the groups at UAF and in Fairbanks. Franz plays for the Fairbanks Symphony Orchestra, the Arctic Chamber Orchestra, the Northern Light String Orchestra, the Fairbanks Opera and several chamber music groups at UAF. He consistently makes the Chancellor's or the Deans' lists with a GPA of 3.90. Franz loves living in Alaska and plans to remain and teach here once his educational goals have been achieved. Someday he hopes to teach and impact kids' lives as much as his teachers have influenced his.

Ani Gyulamiryan, piano

Ani entered the Sayat Nova Music School in Armenia at age five. While there, she began her studies in composition with composer Vartan Adjemian, chair of the composition department at the Yerevan Conservatory of Music. In 2001, after moving to the United States, Ani continued to study piano privately with several different teachers. In 2006 she enrolled at the University of Denver Lamont School of Music. Currently, she is a first-year graduate student at UAF under the tutelage of maestro Eduard Zilberkant. Ani taught music to younger children at Colorado Music Quest premiere studio, she was the official accompanist for the Denver Chorale and has collaborated with other musicians in concert. Ani was a participant and winner of the local Yamaha competition in Colorado, and has attended the Pramberger and IKIF music festivals.

Bryant Hopkins, cello

Bryant Hopkins, a senior at UAF, started playing cello at age four. He studies with Professor Karl Knapp and is currently associate principal of the Fairbanks Symphony Orchestra. Bryant has also performed as the principal cellist with the Arctic Chamber Orchestra, Fairbanks Choral Arts Orchestra, Northern Lights String Orchestra, Opera Fairbanks, National High School Honors Orchestra, Fairbanks Youth Orchestras and was selected to attend the Boston University Tanglewood Institute as a member of the Young Artists Orchestra. In addition to solo and orchestral performances, Bryant has participated in the BUTI String Quartet Workshop and is a member of numerous student ensembles as part of his coursework and volunteer activities in the community.
