**Description**

*ANYWHERE, ALASKA* celebrates Alaska's terrain, wildlife, people, and culture. The new four-part travel/adventure series features off-the beaten path destinations for independent travelers. Youthful hosts, Heather Taggard and Chip Brookes explore out-of-the-ordinary sights and scenes from across the state for a refreshing look at travel in America's northern outpost.

**RICHARDSON HIGHWAY: ROADHOUSES AND RECREATION**

Host Heather Taggard departs Fairbanks via the historic Richardson Highway in search of a spring adventure. In Delta Junction, *Anywhere, Alaska* samples the wares at Delta Meat and Sausage. Further down the road, the Black Rapids Lodge offers a history lesson about roadhouses on the old Valdez Trail. Then it's off to the famous Arctic Man competition, a wild hybrid of ski and snow machine racing. Finally, *Anywhere, Alaska* descends into Valdez, for guided heli-skiing with and a scenic boat trip through the breath-taking Prince William Sound.

**DALTON HIGHWAY: NATURAL RESOURCES AND NATURE**

Host Chip Brookes follows the TransAlaska Pipeline in an adventure that highlights contrasts often found in Alaska. Wildfires and smoldering tundra mark the start of the journey with an overnight at Coldfoot Camp, the center of construction during the heyday of pipeline construction. Next is a visit to Wiseman to explore its mining roots and the Kalhabuk Memorial Prayer Chapel. From there, the destination is Galbraith Lake for a painting class in the foothills of the Brooks Range. Finally, Brookes hikes in the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge, or ANWR, stops in Deadhorse, tours Prudhoe Bay and takes and takes an invigorating dip in the Arctic Ocean.

#### DENALI: MOUNTAINS AND MILESTONES

Host Heather Taggard explores "The Mountain" – Alaska's most famous draw for travelers. After a brief investigation of "Glitter Gulch" and a glimpse of the local nightlife and music, Taggard treks through the back country of Denali National Park nourished by organic cuisine. Next it's on to historic Talkeetna, rumored to be the inspiration for the fictional town of Cicely, Alaska featured in TV's Northern Exposure. Following her tour of the town's main street, Taggard boards an air taxi flight-seeing tour. The flight includes a stop at Denali Base Camp where Taggard meets mountain climbers from all over the world who've converged on Mt. McKinley to make their attempt at Denali's summit.

#### MARINE HIGHWAY: FISH AND FESTIVITY

Host Chip Brookes surveys sights all aboard Alaska's Marine Highway System. Starting in Juneau with tours of the Governor's Mansion and historic Treadwell Mine, Brookes moves to Petersburg to fish for halibut and watch whales breach in Fredrick Sound. After kayaking to LeConte Glacier, it's off to visit totem carver Jonathan Rowan, as he restores 20 totems for the community of Klawock. Our final stop is the Kake Dog Salmon Festival - an eclectic mix of Native ceremonies and picnic games.
