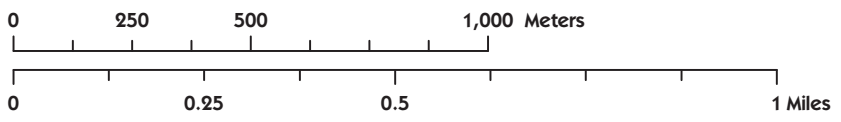


- **WALKING TRAILS**
 Walking, running, snowshoeing. *Bikes, horses and dogs prohibited in winter.*
- **DOG-FRIENDLY TRAILS**
 Skijoring, walking, running, skiing, snowshoeing and leashed dogs. *Bikes and horses prohibited in winter.*
- **MULTI-PURPOSE TRAILS**
 Any muscle-powered use. *No motorized use.*
- **GROOMED SKATE AND CLASSIC SKI TRAILS**
- · — · — **LIGHTED SKI TRAILS**
 Skate and classic skiing and snowshoeing. *All other uses prohibited in winter.*
- **GROOMED CLASSIC SKI TRAIL**
- **UNGROOMED CLASSIC SKI TRAIL**
 Classic skiing only. *All other uses prohibited in winter.*

 No decal required for short-term trail use. (The west campus parking lots are open to the public evenings and weekends.)
