(2) Students will display effective oral communication skills for use in the world of Fishery Science.	<p>ENTRY LEVEL ASSESSMENT:</p> <p>Oral presentation grade in ENG 314 (obtain from records).</p> <p>EXIT LEVEL ASSESSMENT:</p> <p>Oral presentation for each student in upper division course of the student's option within the Fisheries program.</p>	<p>ENTRY LEVEL:</p> <p>SFOS Student Coordinator determines grade upon student's declaration of major or upon student's filing for graduation.</p> <p>EXIT LEVEL:</p> <p>Samples of oral presentation analysis with standard sheets by SFOS Fishery Division Outcomes Assessment Committee at student's graduation.</p>
