Job Posting Summary

During the summer months, Residence Life works hard to prepare our facilities for the residents who will be living with us in the fall. Our student painters work throughout the summer painting the interiors of our facilities, including residence hall rooms, hallways, lounges, apartments and common areas.

Student painters attend a state hazardous material handling training course designed for painters. Certification is valid for two years, and is paid for by Residence Life.

Daily supervision is provided by the Facility Services Housing Maintenance Shop.

Work Hours:

- To be arranged by Facility Services, full time (32-40 hours per week) during the summer.
- Applicants must be available for training May 13, 9am-6pm, and assigned shift times beginning May 14-September 3, 2009, including Paint Handling Certification training dates TBA.
- Applicants must be available to work for entire job duration. Shift times are 8am-4:30pm.
- If you anticipate having to leave the job prior to September 3 for reasons such as being an orientation leader, fall employment that begins prior to September 3, or transferring to another school, you must notify the Conference Services Manager as soon as possible to allow for planning around the absence.

Additional Benefit:

- Housing benefit of a double shared room in Moore, the value of which can be applied to any summer campus housing, including family, graduate and non-traditional student apartments if eligible. Housing benefit is contingent upon satisfactory work performance and completion of work for the entire job duration. Scholarship will be applied at the beginning of the summer. If position is vacated early, entire benefit may be removed.
