STEP 3. Enter Institution Code: 0290-UN37-XY12 (be sure that there are no spaces transposed if you copy/paste)

STEP 4. Fill out the form (if you do not have an employee ID or student ID, indicate your status in the 'other' line; for example: '4-H Volunteer')

Note: you will be emailed a password for your log in

STEP 5. Go back and log in **after** you check your email and receive your password
