

## **Green Wood Bowl Carving (ART F033-F01)**

The style of bowl we will be carving has been referred to as a Scandinavian Bread Bowl and variations on this style are to be found in nearly all cultures. The bowl in its simplest form is a scooped out and shaped half log.

### **Class Schedule**

#### **Friday:**

- Introduction and Demonstration (Materials, Concept and Tools)

We will start by carving a small shallow bowl or tray from the outer slab of a small green log. Through this exercise each student will become familiar with the hatchet, adze, scorp, gouge, drawknife, push knife, spokeshave and more. There is a lot to learn in this process, so we will spend an entire day with the above activities before moving on.

- Wrap-up Discussion and Critique

#### **Saturday:**

- The second exercise, which will take every bit of the next two days, will be to make a larger bowl from a half log. Everything you learned in the first day will be put to the test as will your patience and strength.
- Q & A and Demonstrations will be ongoing throughout the day as needed.
- Sunday will end with a wrap-up discussion and critique.
