This memo is official notification from the Election, Membership & Rules Committee of the UAF Staff Council that the nomination period for UAF Staff Council President-Elect for the next fiscal year is open. The President-Elect serves a one-year term beginning July 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year to assist the president in advocacy and managing the business of staff governance. After one year, the President-Elect automatically ascends to the presidency for a subsequent one-year term.

You DO NOT need to be a current member of Staff Council to seek this office, and you may nominate yourself. In order for any nomination to be accepted, the nominee's supervisor must indicate their approval that they are prepared to release the nominee as needed to fulfill the duties of the officer role. There is a salary support arrangement available to the department of the successful candidate.
