The Business of Alaska Rural Energy: Project Development and Operational Sustainability

Alaska's ~200 isolated villages rely on standalone power systems and bulk fuel storage facilities as critical infrastructure for electricity, heat, and transportation. These systems face escalating burdens from aging equipment, high capital costs, limited local resources, and shrinking public funding—including more than \$1.5 billion in deferred maintenance. As a result, the gap between community needs and available resources continues to widen.

This virtual workshop will explore solutions to close that gap—examining new approaches to financing projects, ensuring safe and reliable energy delivery, and strengthening local and regional capacity to support long-term community energy security.
