








As part of the Climate Scholars program, Axton, a civil engineering major, joined his classmates and faculty mentors on a Yukon River Float trip.


Nanook Pledge - This merit-based scholarship gives you four years of predictable financial assistance, with awards ranging from \$1,000 to \$12,000 per year.

For those who've served — Military and veteran students, their spouses, and their dependents are all eligible for in-state tuition. It's one of many ways that UAF honors and thanks our service members.











