KCL Updates

KCL has some updates for our patrons.

The library is forgiving fines! Any overdue fines that accrued prior to January 1st, 2022 are FORGIVEN! This does not apply to lost items or items that were never returned. However, we will forgive all fines for items checked out prior to January 1st, 2022 when they are returned to the library. Damage fees may still apply.

We are also starting auto renewals for library checkouts. KCL wants to make life easier for our patrons. Instead of renewing online or calling the library we will be implementing automatic renewals. All patrons will receive two automatic renewals for items that are not on hold for someone else. This will not apply to checkouts from other libraries in the Alaska Library Catalog. To remind patrons, our checkout times are: books (4 weeks) and DVDs/Equipment (1 week).
