#LibraryGivingDay is April 3, and it is an opportunity for libraries around the country to raise funds to support library programs throughout the year. KCL provides robust programming for the different demographics in the community. These include our many youth programs, adult programs, Project Homeless Connect, and community events such as the Indigenous Peoples' Day Celebration, author events, Trunk or Treat, WinterFest and Tales on the Tundra. We also sponsor the Dolly Parton Imagination Library, a fantastic early literacy book program for kids under 5. All of our programs are free so that they are inclusive for all members of the community, regardless of income. However, it takes money to provide these programs to the community. KCL has funds with two foundations to support our Community programs-Bethel Foundation Friends of the Library Fund and the University of Alaska Foundation Kuskokwim Consortium Library fund.

Leading up to Library Giving Day this year we are holding several fundraisers to raise money for the many programs that we sponsor throughout the year. As we mentioned in "What's Happening at the Library", we will be selling concessions at our March 1 movie night. Our annual Friends of the Library book sale in the cultural center is March 20-23. We will start accepting donations starting March 11, and we ask that people donate clean and in good condition books. We get asked a lot if we accept donated books, and normally we are not able to, so this is the chance for folks to rehome books collecting dust on your bookshelves! The library will also be selling baked goods, merch, and the coffee cart will be open! Join us Saturday for a cozy afternoon of chess and board games at the book sale. The cultural center will be set up to encourage visiting and reading, so come hang out and enjoy the cozy vibes!




