Library Resource Spotlight by Olivia Stemkowski

KCL card holders have access to many resources beyond just books. These include eBooks, magazines and audiobooks through the **Alaska Digital Library**. We also provide free access to **LinkedInLearning**, an awesome professional development resource that provides access to thousands of courses and professional certifications.

The library also provides access to many databases through both the Statewide Library **Electronic Doorway** (SLED) and the UAF Rasmuson Library. SLED provides access to information on a large selection of topics and a variety of information resources. For example, this platform includes academic resources such as homework help/tutoring, database access and more for elementary ages up through college. There are also many Do-It-Yourself resources such as **Automate** (think Chilton Manuals online) and the Small Engine Repair Reference Center. You can also access geneological information through HeritageQuest Online. In addition, there are tons of Alaskana resources available through SLED.

There is no limit to what you can learn through the many resources available in SLED, and they are available to all residents of Alaska.

KCL is very fortunate to be affiliated with the University of Alaska Fairbanks, which means we have access to the many resources available through the **UAF** Rasmuson **Library.** This includes access to many databases and academic journals. Anyone in the community can come to the library to access these resources. Affiliates of the University of Alaska Fairbanks, such as students and staff, can also access these resources from home using their credentials. A great way to get started with your research is to go to https://library.uaf.edu/research-guides and browse resources by topic.

Catolog, which is an online catalog of library holdings available through 88 Alaska libraries (public and academic) throughout the state. This means that you can go to our website, log in with your library card number and pin, and place holds on the materials available in other libraries around the state. They are then mailed to KCL for you to pick up in Bethel!

Last, but not least, KCL is the proud sponsor of the **Dolly Parton Imagination Library**. The Imagination Library is a free book program available to kids from birth to age 5. Go to imaginationlibrary.org to sign up your kiddos to start receiving a free book in the mail every month!
