





## Kuskokwim Consortium Library Internet and public access computer policy

The Kuskokwim Consortium Library has public computers and free public wi-fi available for use by the public. All library card holders, regardless of age, and adult visitors of the library may use the wi-fi and public computers.

The computers are available for one-hour appointments. Additional time may be requested, and library staff will grant additional time if there are not patrons waiting for the computers. Patrons who know in advance that they will need additional time to accomplish a specific task may request additional time prior to their computer appointment, and library staff will accommodate those requests when possible.

The library computers do not have internet filters in place on them. It is prohibited to view pornographic, illegal and sexually explicit material on the library computers and wi-fi, and any additional material that violates the library's Patron Code of Conduct. Library staff reserve the right to terminate computer sessions at any time if this policy is being violated.

Library staff do not monitor what children access on the computers. All library card holders have equal access to all library resources, regardless of age. However, parental permission is required for youth under 18 to obtain a library card or to obtain a guest pass to use a computer in the library. Library staff respect the right of each parent or guardian to visit the library with their children and monitor their children's access to library resources, including material accessed on a public computer.
