General Rules

- Alaska 4-H Code of Conduct will be enforced for all shooting events.
- Participants must be enrolled in shooting sports.
- Participants have one month to record their scores.
- Participants should have enough time for warm-up, practice, and the shot; a rest period if needed.
- No electronic devices other than noise-canceling earmuffs (e.g., cell phones, range finders, iPods) will be permitted on the range.
- Shots must be shot during the scheduled month and scores must be submitted electronically by the last day of the month. Results will be returned by the 5th of the following month.

FITA Indoor NFAA Field Novelty Animal

Scoring

Will be scored by each round. Any target line breakage will result in the higher valued score.

FITA Indoor Round

Target 122 cm and 80 cm faces full color FITA targets

Scoring 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 One End 6 arrows shot consecutively

Distances Three ends at 60 meters (18 arrows)

Three ends at 50 meters (18 arrows) Six ends at 40 meters (36 arrows) Six ends at 30 meters (36 arrows)

One Round 18 ends (108 arrows)

NFAA Field Round

Targets: 14 targets with at least one fan and one walk-up target, 4 arrows per target.

Distance Marked: distances within the range of 5 to 60 yards

Scoring: 5, 4, 3 from the center outward.

Novelty Animal Round

Target, 30 targets - category 1,2,3,4,5 (no repeats) must include bird from NFAA Animal Round Distances will not be announced but will be unmarked between 5-50 yards.

Scoring-IBO scoring procedures, dependent upon the type of 3-D targets available.

- +11 pts. 11 ring or "X" ring centered inside the 10 ring
- +10 pts. 10 ring
- +8 pts. 8 ring
- +5 pts. Any other body shot. Hooves are considered body color.
- 0 Misses, glancing shots, not touching body color (horns, rocks, logs, etc.

Awards

Awards are given by class and division.
