

# Smallbore Rifle Postal Match

## General Rule

- Alaska 4-H Code of Conduct will be enforced for all shooting events.
- Participants must be enrolled in shooting sports.
- Participants have one month to record their scores.
- Participants should have enough time for warm-up, practice, and the round; a rest period if needed.
- No electronic devices other than noise-canceling earmuffs (e.g., cell phones, range finders, iPods) will be permitted on the range.
- Rounds must be shot during the scheduled month and scores must be submitted electronically by the last day of the month. Results will be returned by the 5th of the following month.

### NRA Three Position

Kneeling - 20 shots, 50 yards  
 Prone - 20 shots, 50 yards  
 Standing - 20 shots, 50 yards

### Smallbore Silhouette

Chicken - 10 shots, 40 yards  
 Pig - 10 shots, 60 yards  
 Turkey - 10 shots, 77 yards  
 Ram - 10 shots, 100 yards

### CMP Rimfire Sporter Rifle

Prone - 10 shots, 50 yards, slow fire  
 Kneeling or Sitting - 10 shots, 50 yards, rapid fire  
 Standing - 10 shots, 50 yards, slow fire  
 Standing - 10 shots, 50 yards, rapid fire  
 Standing - 10 shots, 25 yards, slow fire  
 Standing - 10 shots, 25 yards, rapid fire

## Scoring

Any target line breakage will result in the higher valued score.

Awards are given by class and division.
