



Higher Education Scholarship Application

Purpose

The MatSu/Copper River 4-H Horse Council Scholarships are awarded to the 4-H members that show a strong involvement not only in their clubs but also in the MatSu/Copper River District 4-H horse program. The scholarships are to encourage the 4-H member to further their education in a college or trade school. Amounts of \$500-\$1000 will be awarded to applicants based on the completion of this application.

Procedures

- 1) Applicants must have been enrolled in 4-H and have completed a Horse Project for at least two (2) years, both of those years must be completed while in high school.
- 2) Applicants must apply within three (3) years of receiving a high school diploma or equivalent.
- 3) Attach high school transcript.
- 4) Attach three letters of recommendation. One letter should address your character, one should address your leadership, and one should address your community service. Letters should be written by an adult who can speak to one of those traits, and at least one of the letters must be from a 4-H Extension Agent or Leader. Letters are to be in a <u>sealed</u> envelope. The author of each letter needs to sign across the back of the sealed portion to show that it has not been opened once it was sealed.
- 5) Complete application attached to this form.
- 6) Scholarship funds will be awarded to the chosen applicants after verification of enrollment to a college or trade school (letter of acceptance and proof of enrollment) are provided to the treasurer of the MatSu/Copper River 4-H Horse Council.

Incomplete applications will not be considered. (This includes transcripts and letters of rec.)

Applications must be received at the MatSu/Copper River 4-H Office no later than May 1st of the current year. Applications received after the deadline will not be reviewed. Email submissions are to be submitted in a PDF format.
