4-H Returning Volunteer Checklist 2025-2026

- 1) Enroll in Alaska 4-H as an adult volunteer after October 1, at 4h.zsuite.org.
 - a) If you are a **returning volunteer** and need a new background check (good for 3 years) you can complete a new online form at bit.ly/BGCheck-Online-Form.
- 2) Complete the following trainings at <https://north.alaska.edu/browse/all/ianre/4h/programs/4-h-returning-volunteers>:
 - a) Protection of Minors Training
 - b) Civil Rights Training
 - c) Title IX Training
 - d) Clery Training
- 3) Driver Training only needs to be completed if you will need to drive 4-H youth other than your own. Please contact your District Representative and they can help you with that process.
