Proceeds from the auction of this animal will benefit the Tanana District 4-H/FFA Livestock Education Fund (LEF). The LEF supports the development of 4-H and FFA members' livestock education through implementation of livestock education events and opportunities.

Applications to raise a LEF Animal are due by email to the current president or delivered to the UAF Cooperative Extension Service 4-H Office by 4 p.m. April 1 of the current 4-H year.

The selected applicant(s) will be notified by April 7.

The selected applicant(s) will need to follow the appropriate guidelines for the animal they are raising. The applicant(s) may ask for animal purchase price and start up feed if they need assistance. Selected applicant(s) will be reimbursed for any additional feed used to feed the LEF animal upon completion of the project and after receipts are submitted to the Tanana District 4-H Livestock Committee.

The selected applicant(s) will be responsible for the processing and delivery of any small LEF animals to the purchaser. This is to happen two weeks after the fair unless the purchaser requests otherwise.
