Purpose

The Mat-Su/Copper River District Market Livestock Committee Scholarships are awarded to the 4-H or FFA members who show a strong involvement not only in their clubs/chapter but also in the Mat-Su/Copper River 4-H/FFA District as a whole. The scholarships are to encourage the 4-H/FFA member to further their education in a college, trade school, or used toward other non-schooling endeavors. \$1,000 has been set aside by the Mat-Su/Copper River District Market Livestock Committee to provide a scholarship(s) for juniors and seniors who are actively involved in the district 4-H livestock program at the time of application.

The deadline is April 15 of the current year.

Procedures

- 1) Applicants must have been enrolled in 4-H/FFA and have completed a project for at least two (2) years, both of those years must be completed while in high school.
- 2) Applicants must apply within three (3) years of receiving a high school diploma or equivalent.
- 3) Attach a document signed by your school official that shows a grade point average of at least 2.0. No mention of your actual grade point average is required.
- 4) Attach two letters of recommendation. Letters should be written by an adult who can speak to one of those traits, and at least one of the letters must be from a 4-H Extension agent/FFA advisor or leader. Letters are to be in a <u>sealed</u> envelope. The author of each letter needs to sign across the back of the sealed portion to show that it has not been opened once it was sealed.
- 5) Complete application attached to this form.
- 6) Scholarship funds can be awarded to individuals for purposes other than furthering education.
- 7) Please include one photograph of yourself.

Incomplete applications will not be considered. (This includes transcripts and letters of recommendation)

Complete applications must be received at the Mat-Su/Copper River 4-H Office no later than April 15 of the current year. Applications received after the deadline will not be reviewed.
