#### Program Deadlines



- Conservation Reserve Program (CRP)
   General Sign-Up
  - Submit an offer by February 28, 2020
- Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program (NAP) Coverage
  - Annual spring planted crops deadline of March 15, 2020
- Agriculture Risk Coverage and Price Loss Coverage Programs (ARC/PLC)
  - 2019 enrollment by March 16, 2020

### Industrial Hemp



- Authorized in the 2018 Farm Bill hemp is now recognized as an agricultural commodity
  - Crop Reporting (fiber, grain, seed, or CBD)
  - Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance
     Program (NAP) Coverage
  - Farm Loan Program (FLP)
  - Farm Storage Facility Loan Program (FSFL)

#### **RTCP**



- Reimbursement Transportation Cost Payment (RTCP) Program
  - Reauthorized in 2018 Farm Bill through 2023
  - Reimburse up to 25 percent of shipping costs associated with growing and marketing agricultural production
  - \$8,000 cap per farm

#### Farm Loan Programs



- Loans can be made to produce Hemp
  - Farm must follow AMS requirements
    - Approved license to grow
  - Require a sales contract from buyer
- Direct Loan Limits Increased
  - Farm Ownership Loans \$600,000
  - Operating Loans \$400,000
- Micro FO and OL loans \$50,000
  - Application process geared towards smaller farms

# Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program (NAP)



- Insures against losses due to adverse weather events and natural disasters
  - Covers crops not insured by FCIC
    - CAT level
    - Buy Up is available
      - Cover losses up to 65% of approved yields and 100% of average market price
      - Organic Crops provisions and Direct Market sales prices

# Livestock Disaster Assistance Programs



- Payments made to producers in the event of livestock deaths or feed losses due to adverse weather events or natural disasters
- Reliable inventory and/or crop records prior to the disaster are required in order to determine the loss
