 - There may be implications to highlighting a system wide dive program (UAF may see reduced funding or be asked to only oversee UAF diving)
 - A discussion developed on the current structure of the UA dive program (functionally based ay UAF but overseeing diving for UA) and some of the historic challenges to this situation
 - Discussion about possible transition Plan as Brenda thinks about life after DSO
 - former DSO was given 6 mo salary, then 4, then no additional funding
 - UAF bears a heavier burden of DSO & DCB responsibility
 - Decision where DCB is housed (an academic program vs. health & Safety) may not be up to DCB at some point
