DR. HENRY WICHMANN JR.

PROFESSOR OF ACCOUNTING, EMERITUS

Dr. Henry Wichmann Jr. has served the University of Alaska Fairbanks with distinction in teaching, research and public service from 1986 to 2009.

He ably taught nearly two dozen courses in key areas of the University's accounting program at both the undergraduate and graduate levels; and was known as a rigorous teacher who expected of his students a thorough mastery of often difficult subjects; and served as a valued advisor to student organizations within the School of Management.

Dr. Wichmann, over the course of his distinguished and prolific career, published many dozens of articles and papers; and gave presentations throughout the Nation and around the World; and has had his work recognized by several national research awards as well as an Outstanding Researcher of the Year Award from the School of Management; and as an advocate of the importance of research strongly encouraged other faculty members to pursue their own research opportunities.

He helped guide the development of junior faculty members through his well-considered mentorship; and was active at the University and within the greater Fairbanks community, serving variously as member, Chair or advisor to a variety of individuals, committees and organizations.
