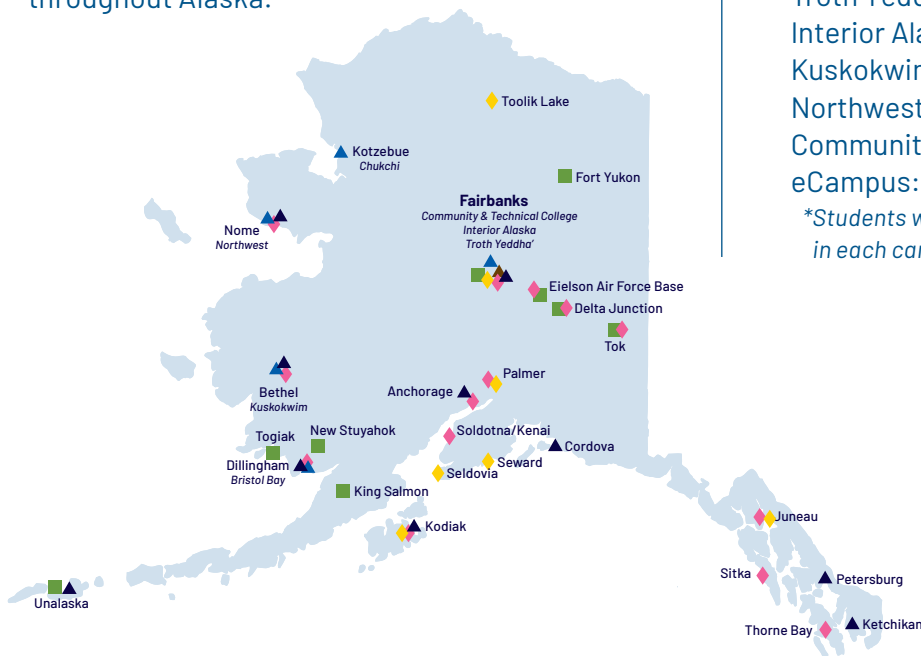
## RESEARCH
