

FY20 UAF BUDGET at a glance







GOVERNOR'S BUDGET COMPACT



FY20 was the first year of a three-year agreement that reduces the University of Alaska system's state funding by \$70 million over three years. UAF's share of those cuts is nearly \$35 million over three years.

ALASKA'S RESEARCH UNIVERSITY



UAF's research enterprise accounted for **87%**, or **\$140 million**, of all University of Alaska research spending in FY20.

FALL EMPLOYEE HEADCOUNT



Regular faculty and staff: 1,770

Temporary employees (including students): 1,439

Labor costs have dropped by more than \$30 million since FY15.

INVESTMENTS



Investments align with Board of Regents and UAF priorities.

More than \$4 million was allocated to priority goals.
