**Subject: Personal Protective Equipment
(PPE) Division of Utilities**

Number: 018

The following personal protective equipment (PPE) is to be worn while working in or visiting any Division of Utilities facility.

These PPE requirements are the minimum requirements for being in the area. In addition, PPE required by a Job Hazard Analysis/Job Safety Analysis (JHA/JSA) or Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) must be worn when performing utilities work regardless of the area of the University in which the work is being performed. All PPE shall meet applicable ANSI standards.

Standard PPE required in areas within the buildings with open grate floors overhead, or in areas that have an overhead crane in operation:

- Hard hat
- Safety glasses
- Hearing protection: appropriate for the anticipated noise level and kept on your person
- Closed-toed shoes
- Long pants

Additional Standard PPE for Maintenance and Operations personnel:

- Long sleeve shirt, and pants or coveralls: fabric appropriate for the work being performed
- Safety-toe footwear
- Gloves: appropriate type for the work being performed
