Museum Expansion - Draft Recommendation

Entrance at Alumni Drive - Update

The entrance is nearly done and the careful observer will note that FS was able to add a car pullout for incoming traffic. There is room in the future for an information area, as per an earlier MPC recommendation. It looks as if the flag poles from Butrovich will be incorporated into this entrance area. Carter is working with Jake Poole and the Alumni Association on these issues and a location for the time-and-temperature sign. The planned location for the sign is used by the DOT for its traffic signal controllers. Probable location will be at the southwest corner of the intersection, in front of the berm. Jake will discuss this at an upcoming MPC meeting.
