Re: MPC recommendation 08-06 – Sculpture at Virology Building

At its May 15, 2008, meeting, the membership of the Campus Landscape and Outdoor Art Subcommittee (CLOA) of the MPC approved the selection and placement of Roger Stoller's stainless sculpture, "Metamorphosis," for the new Virology Laboratory on West Ridge. This sculpture was chosen by the art committee formed for the Virology Laboratory project. Membership included Matt Tanaka, P.E., DOT/PF Project Manager, Terry Schmidt, DHSS Laboratory Manager, Wendy Croskrey, UAF Associate Professor of Sculpture and CLOA member, Joe Abegg, Livingston Slone, Inc., Project Architect, and Andrea Noble, Alaska State Council for the Arts.
