Mangers Report

1. Disc Golf Removed
2. Jason to groom Cutler trail. Complete Trails Committee has put it on the list to expand/improve.
3. Tanana Loop Road is open and being used regularly. Gate to trails is not effective and request to make it permanent to Bear. No crossings marked. Committee is open to a “lolly-pop” trail to concentrate the crossing to one spot. Linda would like a University architect to review the area before we motion. We will request signs for the crossings to be placed by Jonathon.
4. SRC trail is back in front of Butrovich.
5. Ruts need to be fixed West end of the field in front of SRC.
6. Archery Range: Connex was moved. To be sided and painted in spring. Range Management plan forthcoming.
7. Access Control – Lock box at Hut an option. Polar Express key box option, but would require network connection (placed in IARC).
8. Complete Trails met this morning. BDC contractor hired to develop a “greenways” plan. Our draft goals are going to the Chancellor soon. We also prioritized certain social trails that need attention as HIGH priority.
 - a. Suicide Hill
 - b. Trails behind SRC
 - c. Junction to the West of Butrovich
 - d. Yukon Dr Sidewalk
9. Grooming of Arboretum motion is under review by Chancellor Rogers
 - a. Locking the gates motion approved
10. Disc golf feedback was minimal
 - a. Smoking was unfortunate. Mark to ask smokers to not. Consider language for signs.

Public Comment: None.

New Business:

1. Learn to Ski Area: Audun's Comments
 - a. Tight turn around new dish will be a congestion area. Certainly got worse with new construction. This is where his class congregates.
 - b. Too short of an area between dishes and sloped poorly (for skating). Audun used the airport runway scenario and the space it takes to turn around.
 - c. Plan A for improvement:
 - 1) Fix the tight corner and brush out the area south of older SAR dish.
 - d. Plan B
 - 1) Widen T-Field road for downhill instruction
 - 2) Currently too tight for downhill beginners
 - e. Audun would really like to have a scenic trail from the lookout parking to create a beginner friendly loop
 - f. Trees are good for wide protection, but wind not a concern here. Audun could clear the area himself quite fast.
 - g. Audun doesn't like the "stadium" because it is too short and requires folks to go downhill.
 - h. Audun really enjoys the southern exposure view and dislikes the darkness of black spruce forest.
2. Stan's comments:
 - a. Concerned about congestion around new dish.
 - b. Dog leg near grooming equipment
3. Scott believes the ski hut is in the wrong place. Moving the location to the overlook is nice, but the back of the GI is possible too. Scott would like a long-term plan.
 - a. Audun wants the view.
 - b. Parking a concern too.
 - c. Improved trail from overlook needed if hut is moved there.
4. Audun and Stan to put their plan on an accurate map.
