Manager report:

Kara reports a great ski season despite little snow. Shepra is in the shop and taking longer due to foreign part orders. Events calendar for North Campus online. New bike path being used heavily. State funding for second half of bike path has been pulled, FMATS looking to Federal funding. A few options exist, some impact UAF trails.

Army Corp wants to see trail plan before the decide upon mitigations. UAF engineering students are working with Army Corp to get design planned.

Compost pile located on the Eco-dump was brought to attention of UAF campus, including Facilities. Mark said the events of the Eco Dump are not run through NCS and should be. Kara treats the Eco Dump as a special management area, like CIGO, Dear yard, rifle, etc. MPC would need to clarify if NCS wants to be more involved.
