Make a picture of the Earth as seen from outer space!

You will need: heavy white paper cut into a circle, shaving cream, liquid watercolors or food coloring (brown, green, and blue), shallow dish, popsicle stick, paper towels, black construction paper, white paint or crayon, glue



Fill the shallow dish with shaving cream and add drops of color.



Swirl with a popsicle stick.



Press a paper circle into the mixture.



Lift from shaving cream carefully.



Wipe clean with a paper towel.



Glue to black paper and add stars.
