Department of Music Scholarships

CRITERIA: In order to be considered for a **Department of Music** (all of the above except the Fairbanks Symphony Scholarship) the applicant must be enrolled as a full-time music major or have applied for admission to the University of Alaska Fairbanks, with music as the declared major.

All scholarship applicants are required to submit a performance CD or DVD. The performance CD or DVD should include two contrasting works displaying both technical and musical abilities. Please include two letters of recommendation (one should be from a music teacher). In addition, high school and college transcripts are required for all incoming freshmen and transfer students.

All applications, performance CDs/DVDs, transcripts, and letters of recommendation must be submitted by March 1 for Music Department scholarships and April 15 for Fairbanks Symphony awards. Unless all materials are present, the application will not be considered. Complete application materials should be sent to the address shown below.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES: Submit a letter of intent, scholarship application form (attached), performance CD or DVD, two letters of recommendation (at least one from a music teacher), and official high school or college transcripts (transcripts are needed only if you are an incoming freshman or transfer student) to:

To be considered for a *Fairbanks Symphony Scholarship*, the applicant must be a full-time student (not necessarily a music major) and must be accepted into the Fairbanks Symphony. Students will be asked to assist with such tasks as orchestra set-up and will be expected to play in all concerts as needed.

Department of Music Scholarships

The following scholarships are available to music majors during each academic year. Awards are made in late spring for the following academic year. Read carefully, as the requirements for each award differ.

Lesley Salisbury Music Scholarship

Eligibility: 2.0 GPA; Promising music student; Full-time only.

Glenmede Trust Music Scholarship

Eligibility: 2.0 GPA; Majoring in music, preferably stringed instrument; Full-time only.

Bob and Dori Olsen Strings Scholarship

Eligibility: 2.0 GPA; Majoring in Music Education; One award to low strings student, one award to upper strings student; May be awarded to Music Performance student if two Music Education awards are available.

Gale L. Anderson Endowed Scholarship for Music

Eligibility: 3.0 GPA; Majoring in music; Full or part-time.

Tom and Nancy Hallinan Music Scholarship

Eligibility: 2.0 GPA; Majoring in music.

Fejes Music Scholarship

Eligibility: 2.0 GPA; Majoring in music; Part or full-time; Demonstrating motivation, potential and/or leadership.

Edward K. and Alene R. Christiansen Music Scholarship

Eligibility: 2.0 GPA; Junior or Senior music student; Full time; Preference Music Education; Demonstrating motivation, strong academics and/or leadership.

Warren G. Brown Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility: 2.0 GPA; Majoring in music; Soph./Jr./Sr./Grad; Financial need.

Pearl Berry Boyd Music Scholarship

Eligibility: 2.0 GPA; Undergrad or grad; Full time; Demonstrating motivation, strong academics and/or leadership.

Music Scholarship

Eligibility: 2.0 GPA; Incoming Freshman; Audition or live audition required.
